

2016 Riverwalk Swim Club Rules and Regulations

Pool Operational Dates and Times

Friday May 27th, 2016 through Sunday August 14th, 2016 All Days 10:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

August 15th, 2016 through Monday September 5th, 2016Monday through Friday12:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.Saturday and Sunday10:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.Labor Day10:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

Pool Accessibility Rules

- 1. The use of the pool area is restricted to current residents of the Riverwalk community and their guests only.
- 2. Each household will be limited to 4 guests per visit.
- 3. All guests must be accompanied by a current Riverwalk resident of at least 18 years of age.
- 4. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian of at least 18 years of age.
- 5. Remember to keep the gate closed at all times to limit unauthorized visitors. No climbing over the fence will be allowed.
- 6. Residents who organize and hold unapproved parties will be billed for extra lifeguard hours and all party cleanup costs via the Ghertner Property Management Company. Please see the Riverwalk Pool Party Policy for details.

Pool Usage Rules

1. The small children's wading pool is open to all children up to 5 years of age and their guardians.

NOTE: THE LIFEGUARDS DO NOT MONITOR THE CHILDREN'S WADING POOL!

ALL CHILDREN MUST BE ATTENDED AT ALL TIMES BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN!

- 2. The main pool is open to all Riverwalk residents and their guests.
- 3. The adult wading pool at south end of the main pool is open to adults 18 years of age and older. No splashing or horseplay will be allowed in this area at anytime.
- 4. The all-adult pool is open to adult residents and their guests 18 years of age and older. No Lifeguard is on duty.
- 5. Proper swimwear is required at all times. No cut off-shorts will be allowed.
- 6. Children not toilet trained must wear swim diapers at all times.
- 7. Disposable diapers are not allowed in any pool area at any time!
- 8. Glass containers are <u>NOT</u> permitted at anytime.
- 9. Food is permitted under the pavilion area and along the pool deck, but restricted to the patio tables.
- 10. Smoking, tobacco product, and e-cigarettes are **<u>NOT</u>** permitted at any time inside the pool pavilion.
- 11. Pets are <u>NOT</u> permitted at anytime.
- 12. Furniture must be kept inside the pavilion and pool deck areas at all times.
- 13. Please use the outdoor showers to rinse off any oils or lotions before entering the pool.
- 14. All residents are responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of the area used by themselves and/or guests.
- 15. Residents are responsible for all actions or damages caused by their family members and/or guests.
- 16. Storage of personal belongings in the pavilion area, (i.e. floats, toys, towels, lotions, etc...) are prohibited. Personal items not removed at the close of each day will be put into the Lost and Found & discarded at the end of each month.
- 17. ACTS OF VANDALISM WILL BE PROSECUTED TO THE FULL EXTENT OF THE LAW!

Pool Safety Rules

- 1. No diving, somersaults, back dives, cannonballs, or other similar diving.
- 2. No running or horseplay.
- 3. Misuse of pool property (life saving equipment, furniture, etc) will be cause for dismissal from the pool.
- 4. Air inflated equipment is limited to one-person capacity/use.
- 5. No bicycles, scooters, skateboard, or roller blades allowed inside the pool pavilion.

Parents and guardians are responsible for their children at all times.

Lifeguards are responsible for life safety and emergency response—NOT BABYSITTING! Lifeguards will have the authority to dismiss any resident or guest at anytime who is disregarding

these rules or posing a safety risk to themselves or other pool guests.
